Updated Facility Rates for Ambulatory **Surgical Centers** Effective October 1, 2002

In accordance with section 1833(i)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act, payment rates for Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) facility charges have been updated to reflect an inflation adjustment for services furnished on or after October 1, 2002. The statute provides that ASC payment rates for FY (Fiscal Year) 2003 be updated by the percentage increase in the consumer price index for all urban consumers (CPI-U). ASC rates are determined using an inpatient wage index for Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) and their constituent counties. For more information, refer to the Federal Register (67 FR 49982) published August 1, 2002.

Note that group 9 is included with this update. This group has been in existence since the early 1990s but has not been utilized because payment has not been made for the one code in this group, CPT 50590, subject to a court stay (American Lithotripsy Society v. Sullivan, 785, F. Supp. 1035 [D.D.C. 1992]). However, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is expecting to add several procedures to the ASC list effective in FY 2003 that will utilize this payment level. The payment amounts reflect the group 9 rates for all the CPI-U updates since this group was established.

A list of ASC-approved procedure codes and their payment groups was published in the Second Quarter 2002 Medicare B Update! (pages 12-15). A new list will be published in the Update! after the 2003 HCPCS update has been completed.

The following table provides new rates for ASC payment groups for each MSA and constituent counties. Claims for ASC services rendered on or after October 1, 2002, will be processed using these rates, even if they were submitted with the previous fees. Claims should not be resubmitted with a corrected billed charge.
