Changes in Payment for Services Furnished in Ambulatory Surgical Centers for Fiscal Year 2004

This notice describes changes in payment for services furnished in Ambulatory Surgical Centers during fiscal year 2004. The information in this notice supersedes the rates posted to our provider education Web sites on October 13, 2003. It reflects changes resulting from enactment of section 626(a) of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003, (MMA) on December 8, 2003.

In fiscal year 2004, beginning with April 1, 2004, the increase in ASC payment rates shall be the 2003 Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers (U.S. city average) (CPI-U) as estimated for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2003, minus 3.0 percentage points. The forecasted inflation of the CPI-U for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2003 was 3.0 percent. Therefore, the percentage increase of fiscal year 2003 ASC payment rates for fiscal year 2004 equals zero percent. Effective for services furnished on or after April 1, 2004, carriers shall revert to the ASC payment group rates that were implemented effective October 1, 2002. The wage index rates remain unchanged.

The following tables list the new rates for each of the ASC payment groups listed for each MSA and constituent counties. Claims for ASC services furnished on or after April 1, 2004, will be processed using these updated rates.
